Dear LifeChangers Chaperone,

Thank you so much for giving a week of your busy schedule to accompany your students to LifeChangers. Without you, LifeChangers would not be possible. This will be our 15th year of LifeChangers and YOU are an important part of it.

Chaperones will be assigned to a crew just like the students. We will need you to drive your personal vehicle or church vehicle to the work site to help transport the crews. You might want to bring something to protect the seats in your vehicle from getting dirty. Chaperones are also needed in the gym area during the afternoon while everyone is taking showers. It is probably best for the students NOT to take a nap in the afternoon because when they do they don't want to go to bed at night. Please help us with this.

Some of your youth may have other things – doctor's appointments, play practice, etc. – to do that week. We want to emphasize to you and their parents that when they leave for LifeChangers on Sunday, we need everyone's undivided attention and commitment for the *entire* week; otherwise the work will not be completed on time. **PLEASE help your students understand that they do not need to leave at any time during the week.** Also, *NO student can drive their personal vehicle.* All students should ride in the vehicles provided by the group leader or adult. It is best for students NOT to have their vehicles at Calvary.

The rules and regulations for the week are enclosed. Please note the cell phone rules and the dress code. Students must leave their phones at the church during the day. We have allowed them to leave them in vehicles before but iPhones stop working if they get too hot. Adults will have phones at all times. Shirts with sleeves are required at all times – during work and all other times. No spaghetti strap shirts or tube tops are allowed unless they wear another shirt over them. **Remember that LONG pants and closed toe shoes are required on all work sites.**

Calvary Baptist Church is being very gracious to let us use their facilities at no cost to us. Please take care of the property and clean up after yourself. Treat the facilities at Calvary with the respect you would show your own church. Remind your students to **stay in the designated places and not to go roaming.**

Please take time to read the enclosed information. The release form should be notarized. Please have students sign the "LifeChangers Responsibility" sheet and fill out the "Fun Stuff" sheet and return all three and their to the group leader. This year skating will be paid for at the door. (ALL students must pay for skating even if they are not skating. Adults pay only if they are skating.) **One person** should turn in all forms for each group. Please communicate with your students that they will not be allowed to check in Sunday night until their chaperone and group leaders arrive at Calvary. Since this is year 15 we will have tee shirts and hats from past LC years available for purchase. Money will go to BLISS Ball (prom for children and adults with special needs.)
