Last month I wrote about transition. Well here it is the middle of February and it feels like we have already transitioned to spring. Don't put your long sleeves away just yet. I remember snow falling in March before, and the winds of March are often colder than any other time of the year. Remember even though it might feel like April or May, it is just February or March (by the time you read this).

This leads me to some thoughts on "feels like". Feelings can often fool you. What feels right is often wrong and what feels wrong is often right. This can also lead us to be like. Paul said in Romans 7:15, "I don't understand what I do. I don't do what I want to do. Instead, I do what I hate to do". Now while feelings can certainly be the right emotions that we would have as a believer, as directed by living life in the Spirit, there are also emotions born out of the flesh. Feelings and emotions that come from a Spirit filled life, that are in accordance with the council of His word, are always right. Feelings born out of the flesh are always wrong.

So what is the cure for this problem? Romans 7:25 "I give thanks to God who saves me. He saves me through Jesus Christ our Lord". The ultimate cure is new life in Christ thru the grace He bestows upon us. What about the every day treatment of the conflicted nature of the old and the new, the flesh and the Spirit, how do we treat the symptoms? Bible study, prayer, worship, and accountability all work to suppress that old nature that we can struggle with. If we hide God's Word in our heart and mind, it can come forth when we are tempted to be subject to our "fleshly feelings". We "have not because we ask not", ask God in prayer to give you strength and discipline to know the truth. If we ask on truth and not feelings, we make right choices. Worship keeps us tuned in and reminded of God's holiness, goodness and grace. As for being accountable, a cord of many strands is always stronger.

Just as you don't trust how the weather feels when you look at the calendar, don't trust how you may feel when you look at the Word of God. The Spirit filled life will always be lead to truth and discipline.
