North Carolina Baptist Disaster Relief responded to us after the great flood of October 2015. NC Baptist men then took the lead in Rebuild SC until Hurricane Matthew forced them back into service in their own state.

The nature of the work is to serve those who have been affected by the recent disaster. The main task is to show the love of Jesus through words and actions.
