With spring right around the corner I want to share some happening with you! The first is that we have a new website up and running! According to recent research, provided for us from the South Carolina Baptist Convention, our Florence Baptist Association has 4 of the top 100 areas of lostness in the state. Lostness: these are people who do not consider themselves bornagain believers. These 4 areas range from 66% - 70% unreached. The four areas are: Florence (29501 Zip Code), Timmonsville, Lake City, and Johnsonville.

This report also shows the Pee Dee region has the best ratio of attenders to resident membership. In other words there are a greater percentage of members, attending our Baptist Congregations in the Pee Dee Region than in the rest of the state. Also the Pee Dee Region is the only region where the number of plateaued churches is still greater than the number of declining churches. A plateaued church is one that has reported between 10% increase and 10 % decrease in: Resident Membership, Worship, and Sunday School, over the last five years. A declining church has averaged a 10% decline, in the same categories, over the last five years. While these might be bright spots when compared to the rest of the state, they really just mean we are not declining as fast as the others.

Let me encourage you, to encourage others, to pray, reach out, and expect God to do great things. Break out of that plateaued or declining category, by allowing God to work in your congregation and beyond. Don't blame others, don't blame yourself, just accept responsibility to be a witness and invite others to come to Jesus.


