Camp RAE was founded by Pee Dee residents who recognized a need for a summer program to provide therapy and educational interaction for non-mobile special needs children to replace the

programs provided for them during the school months. Since no such programs of this type existed in the entire Pee Dee region so a group was formed in the Spring of 2009 to create Camp RAE. The group received its 501 (c) 3 status in December 2009 and began to work, organizing a Board, raising funds, gathering equipment, and seeking campers. Camp RAE welcomed its first campers Monday, July 5, 2010.

Fair Ministry

This will be our fifth year for ministry with the Eastern Carolina Agricultural Fair. This year the fair will only be in town for five days - October 15-19. Even though our ministry time has to be condensed

into fewer days there are still many places you and your church can “plug in.”

1. Chicken Bog “Set Up Day” meal – Monday, Oct. 14 - 5:30 pm – 7 pm
NEEDED - individually wrapped desserts (Ex- slice of cake in a baggie). Bring to the FBA office by noon on Oct. 14 or take directly to the fair by 5 pm.
2. FREE “Yard Sale” – Fri., Oct. 18 at 10 am
NEEDED items – reading glasses (new or used) shampoo, deodorant, razors, shaving cream, Tylenol, Advil, **OVER THE COUNTER** cold medicine (**NOT** the kind you have to sign with the pharmacist to get), blankets, twin sheets, queen sheets, Duffel bags, NEW baseball type caps, 4 or 6 pack of toilet paper OR individually wrapped rolls of TP, paper towels, Kleenex, unscented laundry detergent, Pop Tarts, cereal, “pop-top” foods (ravioli, Vienna sausage, etc), We will collect these items at the FBA office October 2 - 11. **DO NOT bring before Oct. 2** because of storage issues in the back room.

6. “Snack Sacks” Saturday, October 19
After the fair closes at 1 am early Sunday morning, the workers work all night taking the rides down. The vendors pack up and leave so there is nowhere for the workers to get a snack or something to drink. We are going to pack “snack sacks” and have

cold drinks available. We will be contacting churches to help provide certain items for these snacks.

NEEDED – volunteers to meet about 9 pm at the FBA office to put the snack sacks together and pack in cars.

NEEDED – volunteers to go to the fair around 1:00 am to help deliver the snacks. Need some “night owls” for this!
