I now have a PHD in flood bucket packing! We want to thank those of you that have contributed flood buckets and other resources that have been and are being distributed to the flood victims in Florence and Williamsburg Counties. As of 10/22/05, we have had 77 come in, with more promised and expected. There was an initial need to which we responded with paper products and cleaning supplies in Johnsonville. We also thank those of you that contributed monetarily thru your churches and directly to the Association.

So what else has the Florence Baptist Association been doing for the relief of flood victims? The two shower units, one from Southside and one from Evergreen are being used at First Church Hemmingway and First Church Johnsonville. They are in place to provide for the needs of the many volunteers that have come to that area through NC Baptist Disaster Relief. We have had members of our feeding unit (Hebron) that responded to feeding needs in Columbia. 129 people went through the regional mud out training that we hosted at Greenwood.

We have also had the opportunity to distribute new clothes to flood victims through partner agencies and schools. Remember that this will be an ongoing process that will continue for many months. Here is how you can continue to

help. Mud out: if you have been through the training or are willing to help in some way, you can report to Johnsonville First Baptist Church any Monday – Saturday at 7:30 AM. You will be assigned to a group to do mud out. Monetary contributions continue to be received by the SC Baptist Convention or your Florence Baptist Association.


