Return Service Requested

As I am writing this, it is the Wednesday before Easter. For many years I was able to stand in front of a congregation to bring a message on the resurrection of Christ and what it means to us. For seven of those, I was able to preach at the Community Sunrise Service as well as at the church I was pastoring. We realize that for the Christian, Holy Week, is the most important celebration of the church. Without the resurrection everything else is meaningless. Because Jesus was raised from the dead, never to experience death again, we may have assurance of salvation thru Him. Did you know that Tracy and I brought both of our girls home from the hospital on Easter Sunday? It was another special memory for us.

Remember as Peter and John went to the tomb, to check out the story of the women, they had many questions. After seeing the empty tomb, and the condition of the grave clothes, they had many more. These questions did not begin to be answered until Jesus appeared. The meaningful questions in our life are only answered in the context of Jesus being in our life as Lord and Savior. The struggle doesn't come in allowing Jesus to save us, it comes in yielding our life to Him as Lord.

Remember when Jesus was there, Peter was rebuked for not accepting Jesus plan that He would die. Peter denied that he knew Jesus just

a short time after that meaningful last supper. Even after seeing the resurrected Jesus, Peter went back to fishing and took others with him. So what made the difference? What caused the different Peter we see in the book of Acts. The Holy Spirit came upon the believers and the power that is His. Here is the key to Jesus being Lord and Savior, His Spirit dwelling within us and the power that comes because of His indwelling Spirit.

Allowing someone else to "Lord over us" meets resistance because of our independent nature and our bent toward sin. God's Spirit allows us to be in tune with His desire for our life. Jesus was broken, dead and buried only to be raised to new life. If we experience new life in Christ, it calls for brokenness and death to self that we might be raised to new life. If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Colossians 3:1
