As a result of our efforts there, they are making a monetary contribution to be used in the rebuild efforts following the flood (Johnsonville). We are looking at a possible trip in the fall pending a church that will be transitioning into a building.

The Canada Mission Team will leave on Saturday July 23, as we see our partnership there coming to a close. We have eight members seven of which are from Union. J.D. Weed has lead this partnership and the work in Dieppe as I have lead the work in Miramichi. The church planters we have worked with have made great strides during the four years we have supported them financially and with mission teams.
