Founded in 2014, The Crayon Initiative is a 501(c)3 non-profit that recycles unwanted crayons into unlimited possibilities. The organization's mission is to preserve the environment and enrich the lives of hospitalized children through art and imagination. The Crayon Initiative has collected 9.5 million crayons reducing environmental waste and donated more than 20,000 new packs of crayons to pediatric patients in 38 hospitals in 17 different states.

Last summer, AC Moore Craft stores served as collection points. They are expected to do the same thing this summer. We will be collecting used crayons at the FBA. They can be broken or just pieces of crayons. Just put them in a box or zip lock bag and bring to the FBA office by June 30. They do not have to be separated by color or have the paper taken off. The Crayon Initiative has volunteers to do that.
