In the mall in Cleveland there was a strange sight. Payphones were built into the wall; the handsets were gone and the hooks were modified to be flush with the wall. What was a familiar sight for most of my life, is now a relic. Go to many events now with no paper ticket, but you will have a barcode that can be scanned. Today, I just pull up the app to tune my guitar. Everything has changed so much through the years until..... you walk into many Baptist churches. We don't want to admit it, but, churches are going the way of the payphone. Phones are with us but they have changed from hanging on the wall to, being a computer. While the "baby boomer" generation has adapted to the cell phone, this generation has not allowed for change in the church. Is the focus of church, the comfort and fellowship of those that are already there, or the concern for the lost that are all around? For the local church to avoid going the way of the payphone, she must do things she has never done before and do things in ways she has never done them.

Being the church has to be more important than coming to church. Have you invited an unchurched person to take part in being the church? Have you asked a man to help the church men build a handicapped ramp, asked someone to join in feeding the homeless or go on a mission trip? The problem is when the church is not being the church but only coming to church. There is no place for the lost and unchurched to connect except to come and experience the worship service and programs that have changed very little in the last 50 years.

Most of our services and programs are designed to be comfortable for the 30 % of the population born before 1964. A worship leader, in their teens, describe the hymn "In Christ Alone", as an older hymn. "In Christ Alone" was copyrighted 2001 which makes it a modern hymn, but an older song, to a teenager that has heard it all their life. It is a matter of perspective. Young people can watch and listen to the best preachers and musicians on their phone, but they probably won't. They need a connection: help when hurting, freedom from bondage, and support when struggling. Jesus came to heal the sick, release the captive, and most importantly, to seek and save the lost. Let's work at being the church so we don't end up like a payphone.


