Here we are in another November dealing with the aftermath of disasters. Our area was barely impacted but our neighbors to the north and east had serious impact. We serve as the hub for Disaster Relief in the Pee Dee. In disaster situations needs have to be met quickly and they change rapidly. The first set of needs are often the most basic as in Michael and the Florida coast. Food, water, and shelter were very important. In our counties with floods, getting the wet contents and building materials out is most important for recovery.

Many of you ask, what can I do? Well because of the quickly changing needs, it is hard to have a drive to receive certain items that are needed immediately. Bottled water is sitting around in many sites. It can be used, but if we had started collecting water after the first 48 hours we would have been too late. Immediate food needs are often handled by the Red Cross and our Disaster Relief Feeding Teams. What are the next set of needs? Mud out, this is hard work to remove all the contents and building materials down to the framing. It's dirty work but it is not complicated. You can volunteer for a day or a week, trained or not.

We have encouraged gift cards. Grocery

stores, Walmart, Lowes and Home Depot are all helpful. The churches in the area are giving them out to families that they are ministering to as they recover from the storm. For a Disaster team/church member to be able to give a family a gift card, so they can buy much needed supplies, is a real encouragement. If you want to give we suggest gift cards. If you send them to us we get them to the Waccamaw Association to use through the work sites at North Conway Baptist and Living Waters Baptist in Longs.

I would like to thank those of you that attended our Annual Meeting at Ebenezer. After such a great meeting last year, I was a little disappointed with our attendance. We had less than half of our churches represented. I guess that's the difference in Alex McFarland and yours truly doing the preaching. We might have outlived Sunday night being our best option for the meeting. We will discuss the possibility of having it on another night, or adjusting things to encourage more involvement.


