Our South Carolina Baptist Convention uses a term "At Risk Church ". How is an "At Risk Church" defined? From Hope for Churches SCBC: A congregation whose current status is vulnerable to imminent decline or closure. From plateaued or nearing closure, they are at risk of declining gospel influence in their community.

Here are a couple key questions to help determine if your church is at risk. Has your church seen active attendance decline for more than three years? Are you unable to attract young people and young families to become members and be involved in the life of your church? Do you feel your church is somehow disengaged from the surrounding neighborhood? If your current trend continues in both attendance and giving, do you fear your church will have to close within the next five years?

Unfortunately, some of our FBA churches fall into the "At Risk Church" category. Covid, while accelerating the process, can't be blamed for what has been happening for years. Right here in the FBA we have a success story of how friendship between pastors and prayer among the congregation led to a vibrant congregation at Oakdale, now HRBC Oakdale. There are options for revitalization, restart, and even rein-

vest. There are opportunities for mergers, adoptions and some combination of the two.

Each FBA church has a history, a story, vision and reason for it being started. Situations change as do neighborhoods and demographics. Churches that don't continue to make adjustments don't continue to be a gospel witness in their surrounding neighborhoods. There is hope for churches that are in decline. Your FBA Director can help you in the process of evaluating where you are and the direction that needs to be taken to make the most of the resources available. During the month of April, this process of evaluation and diagnosis, will be presented to one of our FBA churches. Others may consider following their lead.


