Have you thought about the number of single people compared to years ago? In 1960 singles were 6.9 % of the US population. By 1980, the percentage was almost 20%. Now some 43 years later we are very close 50 %. 1 of every 2 Americans is not married. Now here in the Bible belt, our numbers are probably not quite as high. According to Mission Insite (ACS)

Technologies), in Florence County, 48% of the population 15 years old and older are married. Given these numbers, we are about like the national statistics. This includes divorced and widowed but is still nearly one half of all the adults.

Children's Ministry Day Project: For 2023 Children's Ministry Day, we are going to be collecting gift bags for Faith Healthcare (Nursing Home) 617 W. Marion Street. They have 104 residents so we hope to have enough for all the residents. The gift bags are due at the4 FBA office by Thursday, February 23. Joye Anderson will deliver them on Monday, February 27th.

You can collect through your children's ministry or make this a church wide project.

Please put the following in a small gift bag with handles:

A little squish mallow or other Squishy animal – something they can hold on to when agitated; toothbrush; toothpaste; denture cup; anti-skid socks; comb; soft bristle brush

Also collecting – but DO NOT put in the gift bags: Any kind of tee shirt or undershirt size Medium to 2 XL Snacks for the staff (individually wrapped)

Love Packages Collection: In the summer of 1975 God spoke to Steven Schmidt as clearly as could be. That summer, God showed him the abundance of Christian literature that we all had at our disposal and the tremendous lack of literature in third world nations. He began to send their excess literature overseas. That first year he and his wife shipped sixty boxes of literature to missionaries in four countries. Soon the word spread about what they were doing. Friends started bringing their excess literature to them for shipment overseas. They never realized or imagined that from that small seed God would build an ever increasing world outreach through Love Packages.

They continue to send Christian literature to missionaries and Christian workers around the world. Statistics tell us that every piece of literature will be read by an average of 20 people. Each container has at least 1 million pieces, so **the potential is to reach 20 million every time they send a container.** Since the beginning of Love Packages in 1975, they have been able to send over 15,000 tons of literature. Thousands of people have been saved, healed, and delivered as a result of this mission. There are two warehouses where they collect the material – Butler, Illinois and one in Decatur, Alabama. Love Packages currently sends 20-foot ocean going containers to port cities around the world. These locations act as distribution points and have the capability to distribute these materials to thousands of churches overseas.

The FBA will be collecting old SS material, Bibles (any version and in any shape) and other Christian material **April 2-6**, **2023**. Remember the office is closed on Fridays. **Material will not be taken after this week until our next collection time because of storage.** Please box "like material" together and place in boxes NO BIGGER than a box of a ream of paper. Bigger boxes are really hard to lift and the sorters struggle if the boxes are too big. If you need a complete list of what can be brought for Love Packages, please contact Louanne at the FBA office.
